Dear Sir or Madam,

The EU-financed Concerted Action project "BioCISE" (Resource Identification for a Biological Information Service in Europe) has the aim to identify and analyse biological collection information systems in Europe. Project membership currently consists of 20 scientists from a variety of disciplines, coming from 10 EU states and Israel.
